### VILLAGE CEMETERY FOUNDATION FEE INFORMATION

#### FOUNDATIONS FOR HULL CEMETERY

Requirements for preparing foundations for the Hull Cemetery consist of the following:

- All work orders from the Monument Companies will be sent to the Selectman's office. The Selectman's office will send the work order and checks to the Highway Dept.
- All foundations for the Town of Hull cemetery will be prepared by Hull Highway employees.
- Two Hull Highway Employee's are required to prepare a foundation, at a rate of \$65.00 per foot
- Foundations will not be prepared during regular working hours.
- Foundations will be prepared in accordance with the Town of Hull specifications. Monument companies will not deal directly with the Hull Highway employees.
- Town of Hull Highway employees will not be in the Monument companies employ.
- Hull Highway employees will not discuss foundations arrangements with the families. If any problems arise, employees must call their supervisor immediately. All foundations will be completed in a timely manner.
- The monument company will issue **two checks** to the town of hull one check for **\$15.00 per foot** to cover highway expenses and one check for **\$65.00 per foot** to cover employee's pay.
- The **total cost per foot** is **\$80.00**

Permission must be obtained from the Superintendent of the Cemetery for any work contemplated in the cemetery, such as, cutting in flower beds, planting trees, or otherwise disturbing the grounds.

Rose bushes are strictly prohibited in the cemetery.

The employees will take reasonable care when mowing the grass, but the Town of Hull will not be responsible for accidental damage to plants, shrubs or embellishments.

Acting in the best interests of the cemetery, the Superintendent shall have the authority to have anything transplanted or removed upon the lots or graves whenever he/she considers such a course necessary.

Mounds over graves and stone enclosures, or other enclosures around graves or lots are forbidden.

On and after June 6th of the current year, the Superintendent has the authority to have anything that will destroy the grass removed from the lots and graves.

The section behind the Gold Star Mothers Monument and the new section of the Cemetery (Section A) only flushed markers will be allowed (No headstones). {The expansion area of the Cemetery (Section A) shall allow the placement of raised monuments only in the portion of the expansion area designated to allow same. The rest of Section A shall allow the placement of flush markers only.}\*

Any monument, headstone or marker must have a foundation. Designs for all monuments and markers (giving height, width and length) must be submitted to the Superintendent for approval and shall not exceed: Size of Lot or the Size of Monument

One (1) single grave	2'2" x 1'4" - 3 feet high
Two (2) single graves	3'6" x 1'4" - 4 feet high
Three (3) graves or more	4'6" x 1'4" - 4feet high
